

Routine childhood immunisation schedule

Age	Immunisations	Comment
Birth	BCG	1 injection
2 months	DTaP/Hib/IPV/Hep B + PCV	2 injections
4 months	DTaP/Hib/IPV/Hep B + MenC	2 injections
6 months	DTaP/Hib/IPV/Hep B + PCV + MenC	3 injections
12 months	MMR + PCV	2 injections
13 months	MenC + Hib	2 injections ¹
4 to 5 years	DTaP/IPV + MMR	2 injections
11 to 14 years	Tdap + BCG ²	1 injection

¹ If a combined MenC/Hib vaccine is available only one injection is required.

² Only for those who are known to be tuberculin negative and have no previous BCG (see Chapter 16).

BCG	Bacille Calmette Guerin vaccine
DTaP	Diphtheria, Tetanus and acellular Pertussis vaccine
Hib	<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> b vaccine
IPV	Inactivated Polio Virus vaccine
Hep B	Hepatitis B vaccine
PCV	Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine
MenC	Meningococcal C vaccine
MMR	Measles, Mumps and Rubella vaccine
Tdap	Tetanus, low-dose diphtheria and low-dose acellular pertussis vaccine
